1.      Make the Bible your \_\_\_\_\_ in life.

**Hebrews 2:1 (NIV)**, “We must pay the most careful attention, therefore, to what we have heard, so that we do not drift away.”

**2 Timothy 3:16-17 (NIV)**, “<sup>16</sup>All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup>so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.”

2.      The Bible \_\_\_\_\_ us.

**1 Peter 2:2 (NASB)**, “Like newborn babies, long for the pure milk of the word, so that by it you may grow in respect to salvation.”

**Romans 10:17 (NKJV)**, “So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the Word of God.”

**2 Timothy 2:15 (AMP)**, “Study and do your best to present yourself to God as a workman who has no reason to be ashamed, accurately handling and skillfully teaching the word of truth.”
