Luke 23:44-46 (NIV), "It was now about the sixth hour, and darkness came over the whole land until the ninth hour, for the sun stopped shining. And <u>the curtain of the temple was torn in two</u>. Jesus called out with a loud voice, <u>'Father, into your hands I commit my spirit.'</u> When he had said this, he breathed his last."

1. Be ______ to the end.

Matthew 24:10-13 (NLT), "¹⁰ And many will turn away from me and betray and <u>hate</u> each other. ¹¹ And many <u>false prophets</u> will appear and will <u>deceive</u> many people. ¹² Sin will be <u>rampant</u> everywhere, and the love of many will grow cold. ¹³ But the one who <u>endures to the end will be</u> <u>saved</u>."

James 1:12 (NIV), "Blessed is the one who <u>perseveres under</u> <u>trial</u> because, having <u>stood the test</u>, that person will receive the <u>crown</u> <u>of life</u> that the Lord has promised to those who love him."

2. Accept the _____ of your calling.

Micah 6:8 (NIV), "⁸ He has shown you, O mortal, what is good. And what does the LORD require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God."

2 Timothy 4:5-8 (NLT), ^{"5} But you should keep a <u>clear mind in every</u> <u>situation</u>. Don't be <u>afraid of suffering</u> for the Lord. Work at telling others the <u>Good News</u>, and fully <u>carry out the ministry</u> God has given you.

^{"6} As for me, <u>my life</u> has already been poured out as an <u>offering to God</u>. The time of my death is near. ⁷ I have <u>fought the good fight</u>, I have <u>finished the race</u>, and I have <u>remained faithful</u>. ⁸ And now the <u>prize</u> awaits me – the <u>crown of righteousness</u>, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will give me on the day of his return. And the prize is not just for me but <u>for all</u> who eagerly look forward to his appearing." 3. Let go and _____.

Philippians 4:6-7, "⁶ <u>Don't worry</u> about anything; <u>instead, pray</u> about everything. <u>Tell God</u> what you <u>need</u>, and <u>thank him</u> for all he has done. ⁷ <u>Then</u> you will experience <u>God's peace</u>, which <u>exceeds</u> anything we can understand. His peace will <u>guard</u> your <u>hearts</u> and <u>minds as you live</u> in Christ Jesus."

4. Surrender the ______ to God.

Daniel 3:12-18 (NLT), "¹⁵ <u>I will give you one more chance</u> to bow down and worship the statue I have made when you hear the sound of the musical instruments. <u>But if you refuse</u>, you will be thrown immediately into the blazing furnace. And then <u>what god will be able to rescue you</u> <u>from my power</u>?" ¹⁶ Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego replied, "O Nebuchadnezzar, <u>we do not need to defend ourselves before you</u>. ¹⁷ If we are thrown into the blazing furnace, the God whom we serve <u>is able</u> to save us. He will <u>rescue us</u> from your power, Your Majesty. ¹⁸ But <u>even</u> <u>if he doesn't</u>, we want to make it <u>clear</u> to you, Your Majesty, that <u>we will</u> never serve your gods or worship the gold statue you have set up."

Daniel 3:25-30, "²⁷ Then the high officers, officials, governors, and advisers crowded around them and saw that <u>the fire had not touched</u> <u>them</u>. Not a hair on their heads was singed, and their clothing was not scorched. They didn't even smell of smoke! ²⁸ Then Nebuchadnezzar said, "<u>Praise to the God</u> of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego! He sent his <u>angel to rescue</u> his servants who <u>trusted</u> in him. They defied the king's command and were <u>willing to die</u> rather than serve or worship any god except their own God.

Psalm 31:4-5 (NIV), "Free me from the trap that is set for me, for you are my refuge. Into your hands I commit my spirit; redeem me, O LORD, the God of truth."
