Matthew 5:4 (NIV), "Blessed are those who mourn, for they will be comforted."

**Isaiah 53:3 (NLT),** "He was despised and rejected – a **man of sorrows,** acquainted with **deepest grief**."

## 1. Trust God's .

**Isaiah 55:8-9 (LB),** "This **plan** of mine is not what you would work out, neither are my **thoughts** the same as yours! For just as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are **my ways higher than yours**, and my thoughts than yours."

Hebrews 11:33-40 (NLT), "By faith, these people overthrew kingdoms, ruled with justice, and received what God had promised them...escaped death...their weakness turned to strength...put whole armies to flight...BUT others were tortured...they placed their hope in a better life after the resurrection...others were chained in prison...some died by stoning...some were sawed in half...others killed with the sword...They were too good for this world, wandering over deserts and mountains, hiding in caves and holes in the ground...All these people earned a good reputation because of their faith, yet none of them received all that God had promised. For God had something better in mind for us, so that they would not reach perfection without us."

## 2. Seek God's \_\_\_\_\_\_.

**Psalm 34:18 (NLT),** "The Lord is **close** to the **brokenhearted**; He **rescues** those whose **spirits** are **crushed**."

Psalm 42:1-3 (NIV), "1 As the deer pants for streams of water, so my soul pants for you, my God. 2 My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When can I go and meet with God? 3 My tears have been my food day and night, while people say to me all day long, "Where is your God?"

**2** Corinthians 7:10 (NLT), "For the kind of sorrow God wants us to experience leads us away from sin and results in salvation. There's no regret for that kind of sorrow. But worldly sorrow, which lacks repentance, results in spiritual death."

2 Corinthians 1:8-9 (NLT), "8 We think you ought to know, dear brothers and sisters, about the trouble we went through in the province of Asia. We were crushed and overwhelmed beyond our ability to endure, and we thought we would never live through it. 9 In fact, we expected to die. But as a result, we stopped relying on ourselves and learned to rely only on God, who raises the dead."

3. Receive God's
<b>Philippians 4:6,</b> "And the <b>peace of God</b> , which <b>transcends</b> all understanding will guard your <b>hearts</b> and your <b>minds</b> in Christ Jesus."
<b>Proverbs 17:22 (NLT),</b> "A cheerful heart is good medicine, but a broken spirit saps a person's strength."
<b>Ecclesiastes 3:1 &amp; 4 (NIV),</b> "There is a time for <b>everything</b> , and a season for every activity under the heavens. A time to <b>weep</b> and a time to <b>laugh</b> , a time to <b>mourn</b> and a time to <b>dance</b> ."
<b>John 14:27 (NLT),</b> "I am leaving you with a gift – <b>peace of mind and heart</b> . And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So, don't be <b>troubled</b> or <b>afraid</b> ."
4. Comfort God's
<b>2 Corinthians 1:3-5 (NIV),</b> "Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the <b>God of all comfort</b> , who comforts us in all our troubles, <u>so that</u> we can comfort those in any trouble with <b>the comfort we ourselves receive</b> from God. For just as we <b>share</b> abundantly in the <b>sufferings</b> of Christ, so also our <b>comfort</b> abounds through Christ."
Revelation 21:3-4 (NIV), "And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Now the dwelling of God is with men, and he will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away."
