Matthew 5:5 (NIV), “Blessed are the **meek**, for they will **inherit the earth**.”

1. **Meekness is _____ strength.**

Philippians 4:13 (NLT), “For I can do **everything through Christ**, who gives me **strength**.”

2 Corinthians 10:1 (ESV), “I, Paul, myself entreat you, by the **meekness and gentleness of Christ** – I who am humble when face to face with you, but bold toward you when I am away!”

Numbers 12:3 (KJV), “Now the man **Moses was very meek**, above all the men which were on the face of the earth.”

Acts 7:22 (NLT), “Moses was taught all the wisdom of the Egyptians, and **he was powerful** in both speech and action.”

2. **The meek have a _____ spirit.**

Psalm 25:9 (KJV), “The meek will he guide in judgment: and the meek will he **teach his way**.”

James 1:21 (ESV), “Therefore put away all filthiness and rampant wickedness and **receive with meekness the implanted word**, which is able to save your souls.”

James 3:13 (ESV), “Who is **wise and understanding** among you? By his good conduct let him **show his works in the meekness of wisdom**.”

3. **The meek are _____ in the Lord.**

Matthew 11:28-29 (KJV), “Come unto me, all ye that labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. ²⁹ Take my yoke upon you, and learn of me; for **I am meek and lowly in heart**: and ye shall find **rest for your souls**.”

Psalm 22:26a (NIV), “The meek shall **eat and be satisfied**.”

Matthew 5:5 (MSG) “You’re blessed when you’re **content with just who you are** – no more, no less. That’s the moment you find yourselves proud owners of everything that can’t be bought.”

4. **The meek have an _____ inheritance.**

Psalm 37:9-11 (NIV), “⁹ For those who are evil will be destroyed, but those who hope in the LORD will **inherit the land**. ¹⁰ A little while, and the wicked will be no more; though you look for them, they will not be found. ¹¹ But **the meek will inherit the land** and enjoy **peace and prosperity**.”

1 Peter 1:3-4 (NLT), “³ All praise to God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ. It is by his great mercy that we have been born again, because God raised Jesus Christ from the dead. Now **we live with great expectation**, ⁴ and we have a **priceless inheritance** – an **inheritance that is kept in heaven** for you, pure and undefiled, beyond the reach of change and decay.”

2 Peter 3:10 & 13 (NLT), “¹⁰ But the day of the Lord will come as unexpectedly as a thief. Then the heavens will pass away with a terrible noise, and the very elements themselves will disappear in fire, and the earth and everything on it will be found to deserve judgment. ¹³ But we are looking forward to **the new heavens and new earth he has promised**, a world filled with God’s righteousness.”

Revelation 21:1-4 (NLT), “Then I saw **a new heaven and a new earth**, for the old heaven and the old earth had disappeared. And the sea was also gone. ² And I **saw the holy city, the new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven** like a bride beautifully dressed for her husband. ³ I heard a loud shout from the throne, saying, “Look, **God’s home is now among his people!** He will live with them, and they will be his people. God himself will be with them. ⁴ He will wipe every tear from their eyes, and there will be no more death or sorrow or crying or pain. All these things are gone forever.”
