True peace comes from \_\_\_\_\_\_ Romans 5:1-2 (NLT), "Therefore, since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us. Because of our faith. Christ has brought us into this place of undeserved privilege where we now stand, and we confidently and joyfully look forward to sharing God's glory." Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV), "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus." 2. Peacemakers are not . . . Jeremiah 6:14 (NIV), "They dress the wound of my people as though it were not serious. 'Peace, peace,' they say, when there is no peace." Ephesians 4:14-15 (NIV), "14 Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. 15 Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ." Romans 12:17-18 (NIV), "17 Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. <sup>18</sup> If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone."

<b>Matthew 18:15 (NLT),</b> "15 If another believer sins against you, <b>go privately</b> and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back."
1 Peter 3:11 (NLT), "Turn away from evil and do good. Search for peace and work to maintain it."
James 3:18 (NLT), "And those who are peacemakers will plant seeds of peace and reap a harvest of righteousness."

<b>Ephesians 4:26-27 (NLT),</b> " <sup>26</sup> And <b>don't sin by letting anger contro you.</b> Don't let the sun go down while you are still angry, <sup>27</sup> for anger gives a foothold to the devil."
Colossians 3:15 (NLT), "And let the peace that comes from Chris rule in your hearts. For as members of one body, you are called to live in peace. And always be thankful."
