Proverbs 12:3 (NLT), "Wickedness never brings stability, but the godly have deep roots."

Colossians 2:6-7 (NIV), "<sup>6</sup> So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in him, <sup>7</sup>rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness."

Jeremiah 13:23 (NLT), "Can an Ethiopian change the color of his skin? Can a leopard take away its spots? Neither can you start doing good. for you have always done evil."

Romans 7:15-20 (NLT), "15 I don't really understand myself, for I want to do what is right, but I don't do it. Instead, I do what I hate. <sup>16</sup> But if I know that what I am doing is wrong, this shows that I agree that the law is good. <sup>17</sup> So I am not the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it. <sup>18</sup> And I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. I want to do what is right, but I can't.<sup>19</sup> I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong, but I do it anyway, <sup>20</sup> But if I do what I don't want to do, I am not really the one doing wrong; it is sin living in me that does it."
