1. God has a _____ for you.

Jeremiah 29:11-13 (NIV), "¹¹For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.¹² Then you will call on me and come and pray to me, and I will listen to you. ¹³You will seek me and find me when you seek me with all your heart."

Colossians 1:16-17 (MSG), "For everything, absolutely everything – everything got started in him and finds its purpose in him. He was there before any of it came into existence and holds it all together right up to this moment."

Hebrews 4:13 (TLB), "He knows about everyone, everywhere. Everything about us is bare and wide open to the all-seeing eyes of our living God; nothing can be hidden from him."

1 Kings 17:8-16 (NLT), "⁸Then the LORD said to Elijah, ⁹"Go and live in the village of Zarephath, near the city of Sidon. I have instructed a widow there to feed you...¹⁵ So she did as Elijah said, and she and Elijah and her family continued to eat for many days. ¹⁶There was always enough flour and olive oil left in the containers, just as the LORD had promised through Elijah."

2. God _____ you.

Lamentations 3:21-23 (NIV), "Yet this I call to mind and therefore I have hope: Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness."

Romans 8:31-32, 35-37 (NLT), "If God is for us, who can ever be against us? Since he did not spare even his own Son but gave him up for us all, won't he also give us everything else? Does it mean he no longer loves us if we have trouble or calamity, or are persecuted, or hungry, or destitute, or in danger, or threatened with death? **No**, despite all these things, overwhelming victory is ours through Christ, who loved us."

Psalm 46:1 (NIV), "God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble."

Matthew 28:20 (NIV), "I am with you always, to the very end of the age."

Psalm 23:4, "Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me."

3. God will _____ you.

Jeremiah 1:19 (NIV), "They will fight against you but will not overcome you, for I am with you and will rescue you," declares the Lord."

2 Timothy 4:18 (NIV), "The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to his heavenly kingdom. To him be glory for ever and ever. Amen."

• Attribute of God: God is _____.

Job 30:20 (GN), "I call to you, O God, but you never answer; when I pray, you pay no attention."

Job 40:3-5 (NLT), "Then Job replied to the Lord, ⁴"I am nothing – how could I ever find the answers? I will cover my mouth with my hand. ⁵I have said too much already. I have nothing more to say."

Job 42:10, 12a, 16-17 (NLT), "¹⁰When Job prayed for his friends, the LORD restored his fortunes. In fact, the LORD gave him twice as much as before! ¹²So the LORD blessed Job in the second half of his life even more than in the beginning. ¹⁶Job lived 140 years after that, living to see four generations of his children and grandchildren. ¹⁷Then he died, an old man who had lived a long, full life."

Isaiah 60:22, "When the time is right, I, the Lord, will make it happen."
