1. Dare to be a _____.

Ecclesiastes 5:7 (NLT), “Talk is cheap, like **daydreams and other useless activities**. Fear God instead.”

Genesis 37:5 (NLT), “One night, **Joseph had a dream**, and when he told his brothers about it, **they hated him more than ever**.”

Genesis 37:8 (NLT), “His brothers responded, “So you think you will be our king, do you? Do you actually think you will reign over us?” And **they hated him all the more because of his dreams and the way he talked about them**.”

2. Overcome _____ along the way.

Genesis 37:18-20 (NLT), “¹⁸ When Joseph’s brothers saw him coming, they recognized him in the distance. As he approached, they made plans to kill him. ¹⁹ **“Here comes the dreamer!”** they said. ²⁰ “Come on, let’s kill him and throw him into one of these cisterns. We can tell our father, ‘A wild animal has eaten him.’ **Then we’ll see what becomes of his dreams!**”

Genesis 39:2-3 (NLT), “² The LORD was with Joseph, **so he succeeded in everything he did** as he served in the home of his Egyptian master. ³ Potiphar noticed this and realized that the LORD was with Joseph, giving him success in everything he did.”

Genesis 39:6-7 (NLT), “⁶ So Potiphar gave Joseph **complete administrative responsibility** over everything he owned. With Joseph there, he didn’t worry about a thing – except what kind of food to eat!”

3. Be faithful in the _____.

Genesis 39:21-23 (NLT), “²¹ But **the LORD was with Joseph in the prison** and showed him his faithful love. And the LORD made Joseph a favorite with the prison warden. ²² Before long, **the warden put Joseph in charge** of all the other prisoners and over everything that happened in the prison. ²³ The warden had no more worries, because **Joseph took care of everything**. The LORD was with him and **caused everything he did to succeed**.”

4. Don’t let _____ steal your dreams.

Genesis 50:19-20 (NLT), “¹⁹ But Joseph replied, ‘Don’t be afraid of me. Am I God, that I can punish you? ²⁰ **You intended to harm me, but God intended it all for good.** He brought me to this position so I could save the lives of many people.’

Romans 8:28 (NLT), “And we know that **God causes everything to work together for the good** of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them.”
