Joshua 1:6-9 (NLT), "6" Be strong and courageous, for you are the one who will lead these people to possess all the land I swore to their ancestors I would give them. The strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the instructions Moses gave you. Do not deviate from them, turning either to the right or to the left. Then you will be successful in everything you do. Study this Book of Instruction continually. Meditate on it day and night so you will be sure to obey everything written in it. Only then will you prosper and succeed in all you do. No one was allowed to go out or in. ² But the LORD said to Joshua, "I have given you Jericho, its king, and all its strong warriors." "³ You and your fighting men should march around the town once a day for six days. ⁴ Seven priests will walk ahead of the Ark, each carrying a ram's horn. On the seventh day you are to march around the town seven times, with the priests blowing the horns. ⁵ When you hear the priests give one long blast on the rams' horns, have all the people shout as loud as they can. Then the walls of the town will collapse, and the people can charge straight into the town."

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NLT), "5) Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. 6) Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take."

Joshua 6:8-11 (NLT), "8 After Joshua spoke to the people, the seven priests with the rams' horns started marching in the presence of the LORD, blowing the horns as they marched. And the Ark of the LORD's Covenant followed behind them. 9 Some of the armed men marched in front of the priests with the horns and some behind the Ark, with the priests continually blowing the horns. 10 "Do not shout; do not even talk," Joshua commanded. "Not a single word from any of you until I tell you to shout. Then shout!" 11 So the Ark of the LORD was carried around the town once that day, and then everyone returned to spend the night in the camp."

Joshua 6:14 (NLT), "On the second day they again marched around the town once and returned to the camp. They followed this pattern for six days."

Joshua 6:15 (NLT), "15 On the **seventh day** the Israelites got up at dawn and marched around the town as they had done before. But this time they went around the town **seven times**."

Galatians 6:9 (NLT), "So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time, we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up."
