1. Take initiative and be _____.

Esther 5:3-8 (NLT), ³Then the king asked her, "What do you want, Queen Esther? What is your request? I will give it to you, even if it is half the kingdom!" ⁷ Esther replied, "This is my request and deepest wish. ⁸ If I have found favor with the king, and if it pleases the king to grant my request and do what I ask, please **come with Haman tomorrow to the banquet I will prepare** for you. Then I will explain what this is all about." ⁸ he should bring out one of the king's own royal robes, as well as a horse that the king himself has ridden – one with a royal emblem on its head. ⁹ Let the robes and the horse be handed over to one of the king's most noble officials. And let him see that the man whom the king wishes to honor is dressed in the king's robes and led through the city square on the king's horse. Have the official shout as they go, 'This is what the king does for someone he wishes to honor!'¹⁰ "Excellent!" the king said to Haman. "Quick! Esther 6:1-3 (NLT), "That night the king had trouble sleeping, so he ordered an attendant to bring the book of the history of his reign so it could be read to him.² In those records he discovered an account of how **Mordecai had exposed the plot** of Bigthana and Teresh, two of the eunuchs who guarded the door to the king's private quarters. They had plotted to assassinate King Xerxes.³ "What reward or recognition did we ever give Mordecai for this?" the king asked. His attendants replied, "Nothing has been done for him."
